

PATIENT FACT SHEET QUESTIONS TO ASK YOUR GP OR UROLOGIST



It's all about asking the right questions concerning your male urinary incontinence.

- How effective are they?
- What are the advantages and disadvantages of each of these treatment options?
- What type of treatment do you recommend for me? Why?
- If this treatment is not successful, what other options might you recommend?
